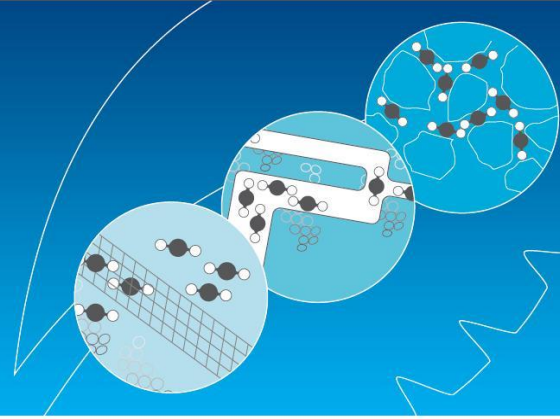

## About the CLIMIT PhD and PostDoc Seminar

The CLIMIT PhD and PostDoc Seminar takes place in Oslo 18 January 2019. The venue will be the Research Council of Norway

The seminar will be a full day meeting where young scientists working with CCS meet to learn from each other and to exchange experience. The seminar will be a combination of presentations and networking. The main focus will be on PhD and PostDoc candidates presenting their projects.

There will also be key note presentations from top level researchers. This will give the audience valuable insight into state-of-the art within some key aspects of CO<sub>2</sub> capture, transport and storage. The invited researchers will also talk about future possibilities within academia and industry for young researchers within CCS.

PhD students and PostDoc candidates working on CCS projects are invited to the seminar. Supervisors, project leaders, and representatives from industry are also welcome.

### Presentations

An important part of the seminar will be PhD students and Postdocs presenting their projects. We therefore encourage all PhD students and Postdocs to submit a one-page abstract of their project to participate in the competition for the available slots for presentations. Abstracts must be submitted to Aage Stangeland, [ast@rcn.no](mailto:ast@rcn.no) by 12<sup>th</sup> November. The best abstracts will be awarded with the opportunity of an oral presentation at the CLIMIT PhD Seminar.

**We encourage everybody to submit abstracts as this is an excellent opportunity to present your project to a broader audience.**

## Cost

There is no conference fee.

Hotel and travel cost:

- The Research Council of Norway will cover travel and hotel cost for PhD students from outside Oslo for the night 17-18 January. Others will have to pay for travel and hotel themselves.
- Details for PhD students:
  - Hotel cost covered for PhD students only if you stay at our pre-booked hotel (details to be provided later).
  - Travel cost will be refunded by the Research Council of Norway after the seminar.
  - Travel refund is restricted to travel within Norway.
  - Hotel and travel cost are only covered for PhD students working in a project financed by CLIMIT or FME NCCS.
  - Hotel room for maximum one nights can be refunded.
  - The following traveling costs are eligible for refunding: cheapest possible flight tickets and cheapest possible travel to and from airport and meeting venue.
  - Everybody must book their own flight tickets.
  - Travel cost will only be refunded if you send us a travel form after the seminar. Please note that we only accept original receipts and signed travel forms sent by post to the Research Council of Norway in attention Aage Stangeland no later than 1<sup>st</sup> February 2019.
