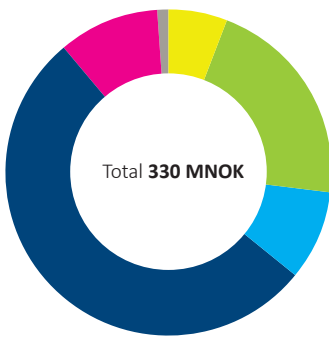

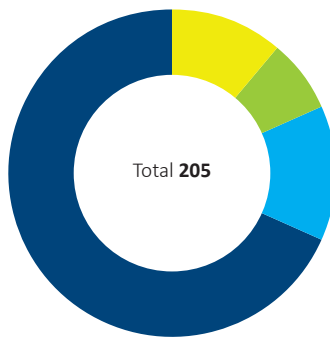
## Sources of finance

- Other sources of income 1.0%

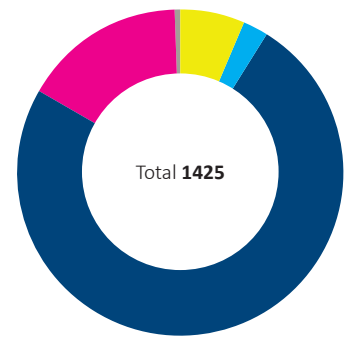

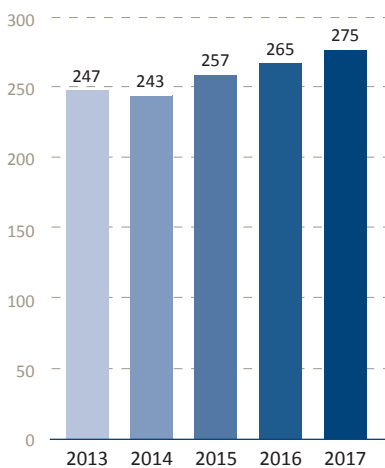

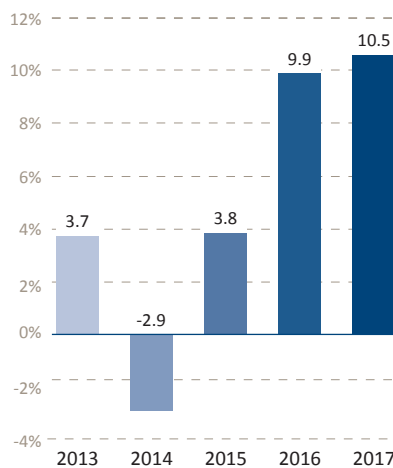
## Net operating income
